- Have no family support in Navarra
- Be in a situation of high vulnerability
- Have been in the Autonomous Community of Navarre for 6 months
- Commit to actively participate in the programme

Description

Kideak is a service based on social guidance and mentoring that aims to help young migrants 18-23 years of age to achieve an integral development. All participants are mentored and receive guidance and training. In addition, if required, accommodation can also be provided.

The aims of the programme are:

- Promote autonomy processes for young people through individualised intervention plans.
- Facilitate their access to institutional and socio-community resources.
- Promote co-responsibility of citizens in the integration process.
- Fight gender gaps by empowering women and promoting egalitarian masculinities.
